## Terms and conditions

You must:

- Be a 2023 member of CF Community Care
- Be a resident of Victoria (including selected NSW border towns)
- Be the primary parent / carer of a child aged under 19 years who has CF

The person who has CF must be enrolled or wanting to enrol in some form of education or training

Scholarships are given to support existing school education or 'alternate educational pathways', for example:

- Towards areas of school curriculum
- Distance Education or VCAL at school or college
- Certificate I, II, III or IV courses
- Pre-apprenticeships or apprenticeships where the student has to pay

Scholarships can be used to cover any combination of the following:

- Tutoring
- Course fees
- Resources / materials
- Study equipment (i.e. text books)
- Specialised equipment
- Specialised clothes
- Trips directly related to study

A completed application form must be provided
